Travelling in the future

Transport today is mostly powered by fossil fuel. The reason for this is the ease of use and the existence of mature technologies that harness this fuel source. However, the **drawbacks** are that these fuel are heavily polluting and rely on limited natural resources. There are many proposals to harness renewable forms of energy, to use fossil fuel more efficiently, or to use human power, or to combine these methods in order to move people and goods.

The list below contains some forms of transport which are not in general use, but are considered as possibilities in the future.

A hyperloop is a proposed mode of passenger and/or freight transportation. It consists of a sealed tube or system of tubes through which a pod may travel free of air resistance or friction, allowing it to transport people or objects at high speed while being very **efficient**.

A dual-mode vehicles is a vehicle that can run on conventional road surfaces or a dedicated track known as a guideway. Dual-mode vehicles are commonly electrically powered and run in two modes: using batteries for short distances and low speeds, and track-fed power for longer distances and higher speeds.

A jet pack, rocket belt or rocket pack is a device, usually worn on the back, which uses jets of gas (or in some cases liquid) to propel the wearer through the air.
